Class placements

We are currently finalising class placements for the almost 400 students who will commence at Riva Primary School in 2022. Should there have been any change to circumstances, please inform our office as soon as possible.

Similarly, if there are any outstanding enrolment forms, please ensure that these are returned to the school well in advance of 31st January 2022. Fully completed enrolments are required in order for students to commence.

We will advise of classroom placement, room numbers and teachers in advance of our RivaFEST and classroom transition program, on 21st January 2022. Please note that class placements may change dependent on last minute enrolments.

Ziggies have extended the cut-off date for orders to be placed online, with delivery / pick-up available from the school on Tuesday 25th January 2022 from 3.00pm – 3.45pm.

programs. While you are free to purchase these items from a supplier of your choice, please consider using the hassle free options available from Ziggies.

Booklists for all year levels are on our school website at www.rivaps.wa.edu.au under “Our Students” and “Essentials.”

For Kindergarten and Pre-primary, stationery items are shared within classrooms and do not need to be labelled. Display books, clip boards etc do require your child's name. For all other year levels, please ensure that your child's name is marked on all items.

Uniform

We still await the arrival of our school uniform into stock, but it is expected in well in advance of the school opening. We will inform all in our school community as stock arrives. As of today, the only items in stock are shorts and skorts. When the uniform does arrive, it will be available for purchase from Lowes at Centro Maddington Shopping Centre. Online ordering with home delivery will also be available once stock arrives.

Welcome Gifts

Each student commencing at Riva Primary School in 2022 will be provided with a school bucket hat and a Riva library bag. These will be distributed to attendees at RivaFEST and on the first day of school in 2022. Please note that the wearing of the school bucket hat is compulsory, and will need to be replaced if lost.

The school is providing the hats directly to classrooms – please refrain from buying the school hat from Lowes. School hats should last many years, and will only require purchase/replacement if lost or outgrown, with the cost payable by parents.
