Crossing

Thank you to Dane Pepper, who has fastidiously monitored, recorded and counted the vehicle and pedestrian movements and crossings at Riva Entrance in support of our application for a children's crossing. The constant, and criteria which we have exceeded by at least double, every single time, is the number of vehicle movements. In every survey, there are in excess of 400 vehicles passing by the school.

In the majority of surveys, we have just passed the criteria for pedestrian crossings, although it does not have a big buffer, and on one day, we fell short – it is however, promising, and therefore, an extra set of surveys have been ordered, just to get the best chance of having the crossing approved.

The data and application will be sent to the Children's Crossing and Road Safety Committee for consideration, at which time, the Children's Crossings Unit will conduct their own independent surveys to verify the data supplied by the school before making their decision.
