Traffic and Pedestrian Surveying - Riva Entrance

To advance the case for a children's crossing to be established on Riva Entrance, during the week commencing 12th September, surveys will be undertaken of the number of traffic movements and pedestrian crossings of Riva Entrance in the hour prior to and immediately following the conclusion of school. The criteria for the crossing is for 200 vehicle movements and 20 primary school student crossings within the one hour period.

A Riva staff member in high vis vest will be stationed on the school side of Riva Entrance to count the cars and pedestrians crossing.
