Please see below for important information regarding our upcoming Interm Swimming Lessons. **Series C** lessons will commence on Monday 15th June at State Swim Canning Vale and continue each school day until Thursday 25th June.

Why do we do Interm Swimming?

Swimming is a vital life skill in Australia, where beaches, rivers and pools are part of our everyday life. The Interm Swimming program supports:

- Water safety and lifesaving skills
- Physical and mental health and wellbeing
- Fun, confidence, and competence in the water

We strongly encourage all eligible students to participate.

Why now?

While we submit preferences to be allocated lessons across all terms of the year, our school has consistently been given dates in Term Two due to demand and our size.

While our sessions once again fall during the cooler weather, we are pleased to have been allocated State Swim Canning Vale for both Series A and Series C. Benefits include:

- Heated indoor pool (32°C water temperature)
- Exclusive use for our students (no public access)
- Familiar staff and facilities for smooth integration

Students are only outside briefly when boarding and exiting the bus.

Swimming is part of the school curriculum, and all students are expected to participate where possible. If your child is **not** participating:

- Please notify the school in writing (riva.ps@education.wa.edu.au), with reason by Wednesday 10th June 2026.
- They will remain at school and complete an alternative learning program.

What to Bring and Wear

- ☑ Arrive at school in **swimming attire**, with a **towel/robe/poncho/jacket** over the top
- ☑ Bring **enclosed shoes for school** (can wear thongs to/from pool)
- ☑ **Hair tied back; no jewellery** (can be given to teacher for safekeeping)
- ☑ A **waterproof/plastic bag** for wet clothes
- ☑ Students will dry off, wrap up, and return to school to change back into dry clothes
- ☑ For **final session students**, teachers will coordinate with families regarding dismissal preferences (this session arrives approximately 5 minutes past our normal dismissal time).

Label everything!

Students will be changing twice daily — please clearly label all items to avoid loss or mix-ups.

Lunches and Breaks

- Students attending **Sessions 3 and 4 will be unable to order lunch** through Munch Box due to the swimming lesson occurring over the regular school lunch break.
- Teachers will adjust break and eating times (e.g., early lunch, late recess) to ensure students are properly supported.

Transport and Supervision

- Students will travel on modern, seatbelt-equipped buses from Bus West
- Pickup/drop-off at our undercover bus bay
- Minimum six Riva staff accompany each group, in addition to swimming instructors
- Extra support staff are available to assist individual student needs.

Parent spectators

Parents are welcome to visit State Swim Canning Vale and observe from the **designated viewing area**.

Please note:

- **No photography is allowed**
- No food is permitted inside the centre
- Observers must avoid distracting students and instructors.
